- -Commissioner Spruill suggested to the board that the town should donate two loads of rock to the Ruritan Building for their parking area and made a motion to do so. Commissioner Logan seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
- -The clerk informed the board that the town is going to be receiving some American Rescue Plan money and a proposed budget is needed for it.
